

UNLOADING

Upon receiving material, check shipment against shipping list for shortages and damages. Marlyn will not be responsible for shortage or damages unless they are noted on the shipping list.

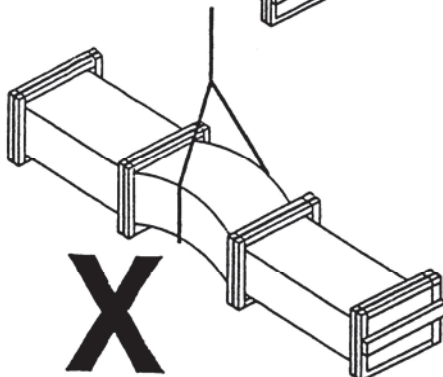
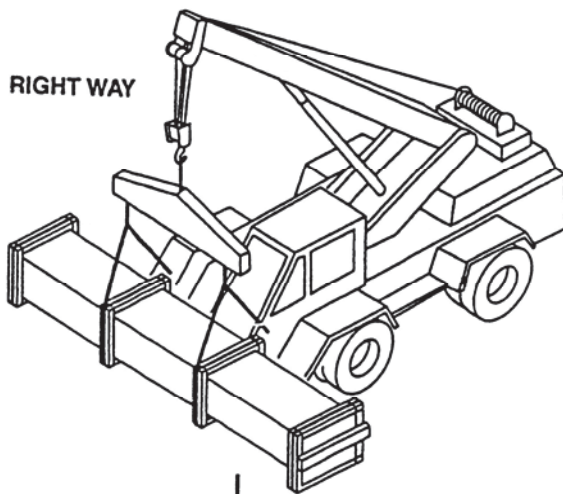
Each bundle should be lifted at its center of gravity. Where possible, bundles should remain banded until final placement on the roof. If bundles must be opened, they should be retied before lifting.

When lifting bundles with a crane, a spreader bar and nylon straps should be used. **NEVER USE WIRE ROPE OR CHAIN SLINGS, THEY WILL DAMAGE THE PANELS.**

When lifting bundles with a forklift, forks must be 33% of panel lengths. Do not transport open bundles. Drive slowly when crossing rough terrain to prevent panel buckling.
